Anti Ragging Policy

Ragging is defined as any act, conduct, or practise that involves senior students using their dominance over junior students who are newly enrolled or who are in any other way viewed as juniors by other students, including physical or psychological assault, threats against other students, use of force, and violations of a student's dignity and honour. It can also involve verbal abuse, grouping, indecent gestures, and obscene behaviour.

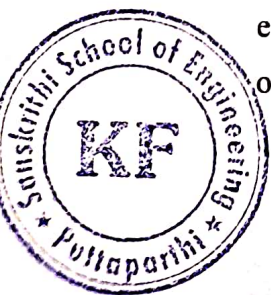
Objective of the Committee

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of 2006 dated 16-05-2007 and in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, dated 08-05-2009 to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging at the institute level.

In order to maintain a culture of a ragging-free environment on the college campus, the Anti-Ragging Committee will serve as the Supervisory and Advisory Committee. Under the supervision of the anti-ragging committee, the Anti-Ragging Squad office holders will conduct inspections of facilities such as hostel, buses, canteen, classrooms, and other areas in the campus. The Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in creating strategies and action plans for reducing the threat of ragging at the institute by implementing a variety of activities.

What constitutes Ragging at Sanskrithi

1. Any conduct by any student(s) whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
2. Indulging in undisciplined activities by any student(s) which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
3. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.

4. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
5. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
6. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
8. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
9. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Actions to be taken against students for indulging and abetting ragging:

1. The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
2. The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.
3. Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible Punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-
 - a. Cancellation of admission
 - b. Suspension from attending classes
 - c. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
 - d. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination/ other evaluation process
