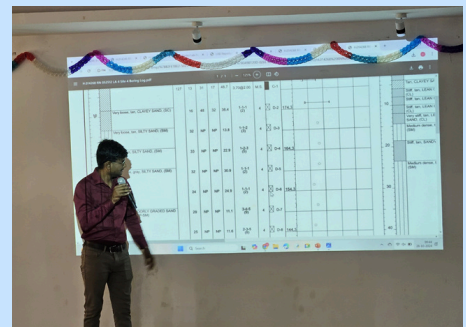
### **Bootcamp on Embedded Systems**

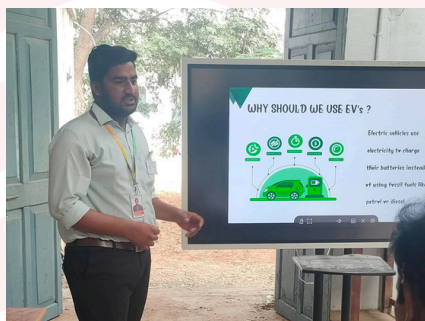

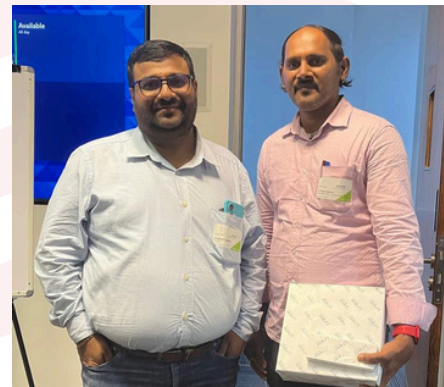
# TRANSCENDING THE CLASSROOMS

The School of Engineering commenced operations in 2015, providing a four-year Bachelor of Technology degree in CSE, ECE, EEE, Civil, and Mechanical Engineering, with 360 students enrolling each year.

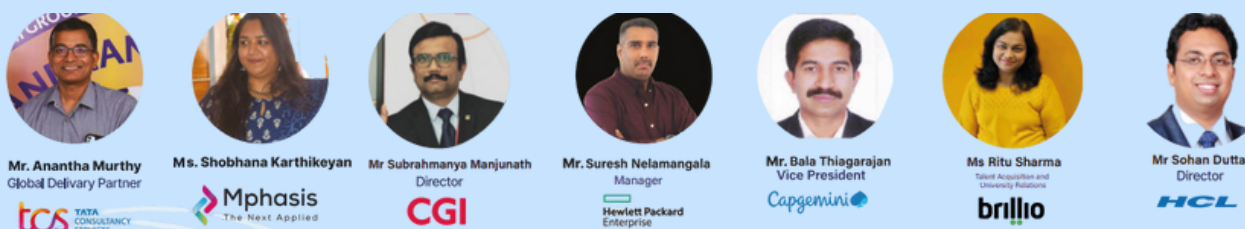
